The Biology Club Mentor position is a volunteer position. There are no paid positions for mentors. It requires a two-semester commitment. A mentor provides leadership and mentorship to a Freshman or Sophomore student academically, socially, and personally. The mentor should provide a supportive, positive environment to help the student succeed academically and personally as well as gain a sense of community at CSU.

- Attend training during the week of October 10th for a total of 4 hours. (This will be held according to mentors' schedules.)
- Meet individually with your assigned student 3 times a semester.
- Attend 3 scheduled group activities a semester. (Group activities will include speakers and community service.)
- Meet with the Biology Club Advisor once each semester.
