Re: National Asset Program Additional Authorizations

This memo confirms the authorization of the following projects. These projects are deemed necessary to maintain the continued classified research effort being conducted jointly through the NAP AR-51 and the CIA/AR Science Directorate in conjunction with the Advanced Research Projects Agency. The DOD and NSA are authorized to begin development of all necessary tools to complete the following tasks:

1. Prevention of the AR-51 project facilities from appearing on any and all aerial surveys, maps or ground based images.
2. Prevention of all overflights of the AR-51 facilities with a 25 mile perimeter.
3. Continued monitoring of the 1964 Socorro, NM incident and debriefing of all military personnel involved with the White Sands live GNV test that resulted in the incident.
4. Continue Project Bluebook disinformation working group.
5. Pay for continued placement of screenplays regarding UFOs with major television and movie studios.
6. Begin payments to faculty at the NYU and USC film schools to encourage film students to use UFO themes. Identify those students who would be candidates to pitch the screenplays to as a means of misdirecting general public opinion.
7. Authorize the ghostwriting of new articles and books representing UFOs from a "crackpot" perspective.
8. Monitoring of all telecommunications regarding terms listed in Directive DC-561/AR224 by the NSA for the determination of potential espionage, foreign and domestic regarding NAP AR-51.
