Metric Bibliography/Metric Information CD contains an index to *Metric Today* and to past issues of this newsletter, as well as newsletters of other organizations. It also contains an extensive bibliography of articles about the metric system, metrication, and related standards published in English-language magazines, newspapers, periodicals, journals, and other serial publications.
